

Terms and Conditions

Bookings will only be processed once full payment has been received. No refunds will be available for any reason for cancellations received within two weeks before the course start date, including illness. Cancellations received prior to two weeks before the start date will be refunded in full, minus a 5% administration fee. *Minor to Major* reserves the right to cancel a course in the event of unforeseen circumstances, in which case all money will be refunded. We also reserve the right not to accept an individual on to a course for whatever reason.

Behaviour

It is very important to us that a friendly and informal atmosphere is maintained throughout the course. To ensure the enjoyment, safety and well-being of everyone involved, *Minor to Major* reserves the right to exclude any student whose behaviour is unacceptable or disruptive, or who is unable to co-operate with instructions given by staff. No refund will be available and any associated costs, such as transport home, will be the parent's responsibility. Smoking and the consumption of alcohol by students is strictly not allowed. Costs due to deliberate or reckless damage to the venue, property, or *Minor to Major* possessions will be the responsibility of the course member and their parents.

Activities

During courses we often organise games and activities at break and lunch times. Please note that whilst every effort is made to ensure the safety of all participants, there will inevitably be a small risk of accidental injury when taking part in any activity. Participation is entirely at your child's own risk and attendance on the course involves acceptance of this risk.

Medicine and First Aid

Minor to Major guarantee to have first aid trained staff at every rehearsal. All medical issues or conditions must be disclosed to the course leader at the start of the course to ensure the safety of its members and staff.
